

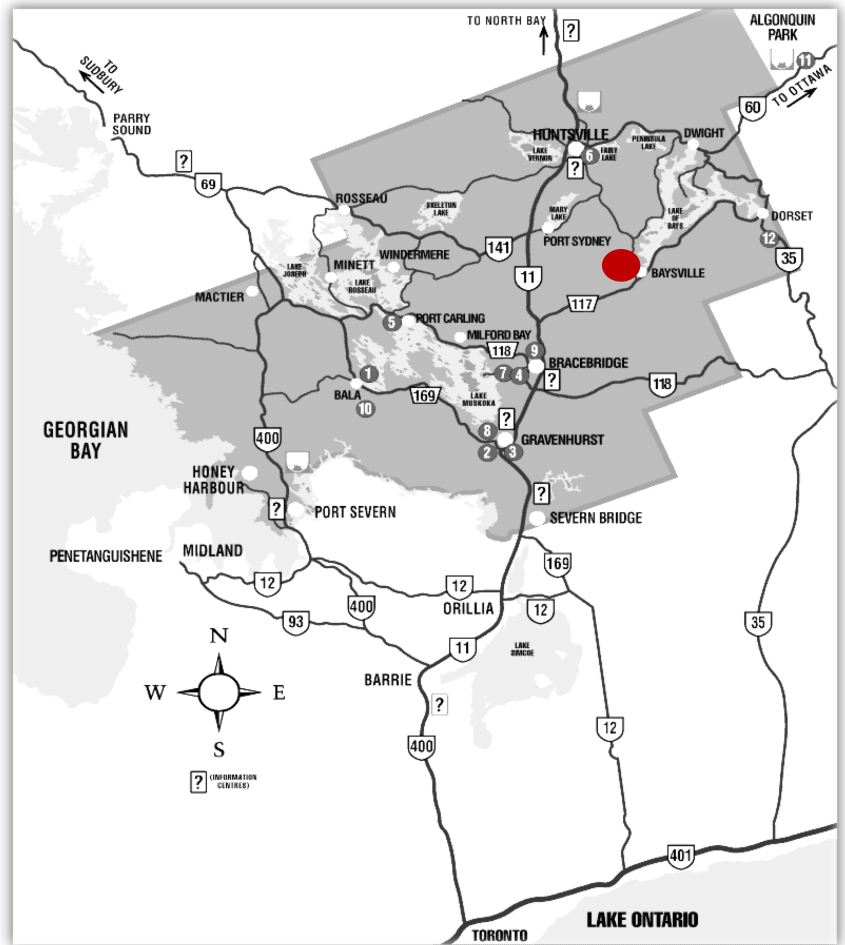
DIRECTIONS TO CAMP

From ANY LOCATION: Use Google or Apple Maps by entering “1068 Burlmarie Road”

Travel time is about 2 hours from Toronto.

From Toronto:

- Follow HWY 400 north to Barrie, continuing on HWY 11 North, past Gravenhurst and Bracebridge
- Just past Bracebridge, take Hwy. 117 east to Baysville for 16 kilometers (about 12 minutes)
- In Baysville (just past LCBO), turn left (north) on Brunel Road for about 1 kilometer, then...
- Turn right on Burlmarie Road and travel for $\frac{3}{4}$ of a kilometer - Camp sign and road will be on the right.



From Ottawa:

- Best route is through Algonquin Park along HWY 60
- Take HWY 60 through the park, passing the town of Dwight
- After about 3 km, turn Left on Muskoka Rd. 9 (Portage Rd.)
- Follow Muskoka Rd. 9 for about 23 km, then turn left on Brunel Road (for about 5.5 km)
- Turn left on Burlmarie Road and travel $\frac{3}{4}$ of a kilometer - Camp sign and road will be on the right.

From Montreal:

- Fastest and best routing is via Ottawa and through Algonquin Park (see above)
